

NAVIGATING NOT ONE BUT TWO PHILIPS RECALLS

In June 2021, Philips Respironics issued a voluntary recall on certain PAP devices, because the sound abatement foam was releasing potentially carcinogenic debris when exposed to high heat; the same high heat commonly used in CPAP cleaners.

Last month, several CPAP masks were also recalled by Philips Respironics, because the magnets used to connect parts of the masks could interfere with certain metallic medical devices or metallic objects in the body; such as pacemakers, stents, implants, etc.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PATIENTS

It was instructed by the Food & Drug Administration (FDA) that any patients affected by either recall stop using the device and consult their physician about other options. Aeroflow Sleep is taking that one step further:

GET SET UP WITH A CPAP MACHINE

Although it is the responsibility of Philips Respironics to replace your recalled PAP machine, Aeroflow Sleep can simply get you a new one if your CPAP machine is more than 5 years old. Our stock is constantly being replenished despite nationwide shortages, so we can ship yours within weeks; not months.

SWITCH TO A NON-MAGNETIC CPAP MASK

Masks that have been ordered from Aeroflow Sleep can be swapped out for free within the first 30 days of use. And if yours doesn't meet that requirement, Aeroflow Sleep can still provide you with a non-magnetic CPAP mask through insurance; setting you up for success with an endless variety of different fits.
