WHAT IS A DEDUCTIBLE?

A deductible, as it's applied to health insurance, is the amount you have to pay for a medical service or product before your insurance plan will cover any part of the same service or product.

How Much Is My Deductible?

During open enrollment, you choose if you want a low-deductible or high-deductible insurance plan. For example, you may pay \$500 before your insurance begins to cover the cost, or \$1,000.

If you're prone to accidents, you should choose a low-deductible insurance plan, because you don't want to wait for insurance to pay. If you're usually very healthy, you can opt for a high-deductible plan, because your coinsurance will be lower.

What Happens Once I've Met My Deductible?

Once your deductible is met, or you've paid the low or high amount on your own, your insurance will begin to cover the cost of in-network medical expenses, after coinsurance is applied.

Your insurance provider still determines for which practices and/or items they are willing to pay; this list makes up what's in-network. Then, coinsurance is the percentage you are obligated to pay both before and after your deductible is met. Sometimes, it's nothing, or in the case of Medicare, it's 20%.

Use It Or Lose It

Meeting your deductible is a big achievement! It's literally money that you have already spent, so best make the most of it...otherwise, you will lose it.

Deductibles reset at the end of every year, and since we're coming up on 2024, consider this your reminder to order new CPAP supplies. Your insurance may pay for them in full, but hurry! **Your order must ship by December 29, 2023 to apply this year's deductible.**


