WHEN IS OPEN ENROLLMENT?

Open enrollment is when you can apply for or change your health insurance in the United States, except that time varies depending on each plan.

I Want To Enroll In Medicare: The Nation's Answer To Health Insurance

The most urgently approaching deadline to enroll is for Medicare. If you're interested and eligible, you may begin to apply on October 15th.

Medicare will cover 80% of the costs associated with your CPAP therapy if you meet their requirements. A list of requirements and more insurance details can be found on the blog:

I Want To Enroll In Medicaid: A State Government Solution For Healthcare On the flip side, Medicaid allows you to apply at any time. Each state manages its own Medicaid plan though, so it's not so much a matter of when you qualify but where. It's probably safe to say that your CPAP machine will be covered, but supplies may be a different story. Contact your local legislature before applying.

I Want To Enroll In A Private Health Plan; Such As Aetna, Clgna, or Humana Finally, open enrollment for private insurance is dependent on your employer's fiscal year. Aeroflow Sleep, for example, lets its associates apply for new health plans in June. The exception to the rule is a life-changing event; like marriage, birth or adoption, etc.

The likelihood of CPAP being covered through a private health plan is high, especially if you enroll in Medicare or Medicaid as secondary insurance. Just make sure the Durable Medical Equipment provider who you choose is innetwork. Aeroflow Sleep accepts most *and* is accredited by Medicare and Medicaid, so let us know when you enroll!
